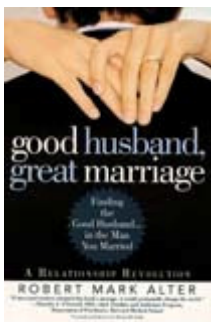
3. **THINK ABOUT IT!**
